The project includes: the installation of a 84' long x 8' span x 6' tall precast box culvert, backfill, riprap, slope restoration, water main relocation and road restoration.

BID SECURITY - No Bid shall be received unless accompanied by a certified check or satisfactory Bid Bond payable to the Owner in an amount no less than five percent (5%) of the maximum bid as a guarantee, that if the Bid is accepted, the Bidder will execute and file the Contract, Performance and Payment Bonds, and Insurance Certification, as required by the Contract Documents within fifteen (15) days after the Notice of Award and may not be withdrawn for a period of 45 days after bid deadline.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.

QUALIFICATIONS - Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) prequalification classification for this project is **235Ea**. Bidders must have the proper classification and numerical rating required for the work bid.

GOVERNMENT LAWS AND REGULATIONS – Prevailing/Davis Bacon Wages are not required for this project.
